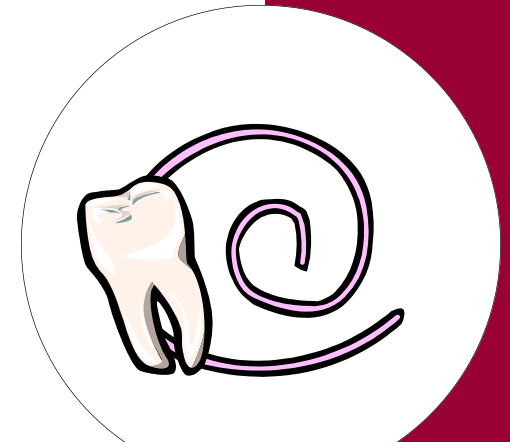
**REGISTRO:** En la clínica Dental de LCC en sábado, 10 de marzo, 2007 a las 9:00 am hasta 11:30 am.

## Children's Free Dental Sealant Program

Arrive Between  
9:00 a.m. and 11:30 am  
Lane Community College Dental Clinic  
4000 East 30th Avenue, Eugene OR

**AGES:** 7 years to 14 years old. This is a free Dental Sealant Clinic for children who have limited access to dental care

**PARENT OR GUARDIAN:** MUST be present to fill out and sign the child's health history and to authorize treatment. There will be Spanish speaking persons available to assist you through this clinic.

**TREATMENT TO BE PROVIDED:** Each child ages 7 to 14 years will have BWX's (x-rays) and an examination by a dentist. The dentist will determine if sealants are an appropriate preventive treatment for your child: decay free permanent molars will benefit from this plastic coating.

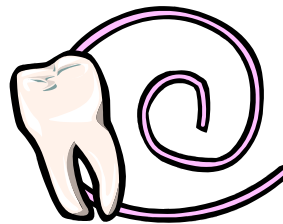

The clinic is open to the general public with emphasis on adult patients who have not had regular preventive dental care. It is our policy to alternate periodic oral hygiene services with the client's general dentist.
