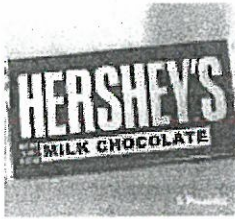


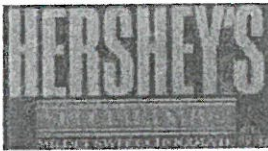
Hershey Personality Test



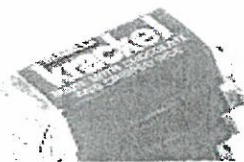
