Head Start of Lane County

Policy Council Representative Job Description

Purpose: To participate in the process of making decisions about the nature and operation of Head Start of Lane County.

Qualifications:

- 1. Must be a parent of a currently enrolled child in Head Start of Lane County and be elected by the parent committee.
- 2. A representative of the community that has an interest in low-income families, can contribute to the program, and has been approved by Policy Council.

Representatives Cannot:

- 1. Be an employee or a family member of an employee of Head Start of Lane County.
- 2. Have served on a Policy Council for more than five years.

Tasks:

- 1. Attend New Council Orientation offered in October.
- 2. Attend Policy Council meetings: 2nd Tuesday of the month from 6:00pm-9:00pm. Childcare and mileage costs will be offered at a flat rate based on location and number of children.
- 3. Share in decision-making process for Head Start of Lane County.
- 4. Encourage parent participation in the program.
- 5. Participate in agency committees as the parent representative: Curriculum, Enrollment and Trauma Informed Care.

Areas of Responsibility:

Operating Responsibilities

- 1. Establish and maintain procedures for hearing and working with Head Start of Lane County to resolve community complaints about the program.
- 2. Approve or disapprove the following:
 - a. Policies and procedures of program operations.
 - b. The reimbursement rate for Policy Council member expenses.
 - c. The proposed actions of hiring and firing of Head Start of Lane County staff.
 - d. The funding applications and amendments.
 - e. The annual self-assessment.

Other Responsibilities

- 1. Serve as a link between public, private and local organizations, the Board of Directors and the community served.
- 2. Have the opportunity to initiate suggestions and ideas for program improvements.
- 3. Can attend community events with the Enrollment staff to promote Head Start enrollment and services to community residents and community organizations.
